There is a £60 per term Sibling Bursary for second and third members of a family. Families of four children are charged full fees for the first three children and the fourth child is educated free.

Laboratory consumables fee is a once-only payment made by pupils joining the school at R8 or above and is £200 covering laboratory and computer supplies.

From R11 specialist textbooks are charged as provided and owned by pupils. There is an active resale and second hand scheme for books in good condition.

The registration fee (non-returnable) for new pupils is £35.

Public examination entry fees, per GCSE or A level subject, are payable at the time of examination entry.
