**The Cathedral Choir** has recently returned from a concert tour of Paris, performing at the magnificent church of Gabriel Fauré, the Madeleine, and the famous Nôtre Dame Cathedral. Our fifty or so choristers enjoyed trips throughout Paris, and experienced impressive views from the top of the Arc de Triomphe and a picturesque cruise on the River Seine.

In recent years the choir has performed Tallis's spectacular motet for forty voices *Spem in alium* with Llandaff Cathedral Choral Society and the choir of St Bavo's Cathedral (Haarlem, Netherlands), Schubert's *Mass in G* with the Chamber Strings of Melbourne (Australia), and in concert at St David's Hall, the Choir has performed Handel *Messiah*, Vaughan Williams *Five Mystical Songs* and Bach *St John Passion*. The choir appears regularly in broadcast, most recently singing motets by Bruckner and Weelkes on BBC Radio, and our boy and girl choristers sang in the 2009 'Christmas Special' of BBC's *Doctor Who*.
