CHILDCARE VOUCHER POLICY

This policy applies to all three sections of the School: the Senior School, Junior School and EYFS (Infants). **Version: October 2018**

This policy is reviewed annually by the Governing Body - The Board of Trustees, and was last reviewed in: **TBC**

As you will be aware, there are strict Government guidelines over the use of childcare vouchers. St John's College does accept childcare vouchers but only for activities specified within the rules of the Government Childcare Voucher Scheme.

Childcare vouchers are only acceptable for the following eligible activities:

- After School club fees, including Breakfast and Homework Club (but **not** for equipment, kit, materials or exams for these clubs). Clubs also include Breakfast and Homework clubs;
- Holiday Clubs located on the schools registered premises, such as Sports Camp;
- Nursery Fees.

Vouchers are **NOT** eligible for use for the following:

- School Fees;
- School Trips during school hours or related to the school curriculum;
- Residential or day trips that take place away from the school's registered premises.
