Monthly payments

Monthly payments, based upon full school fees, may be made in three monthly instalments per term by Standing Order. Please contact the Finance Manager for further details. (fees@stjohnscollegecardiff.com)

Sibling Bursary

While families of 2 or 3 children are at the school concurrently:

(i) full fees will be charged for the first child; and (ii) both the second and third child will each qualify for a 'Sibling Bursary' of £60 per term.

Fourth Child Free

While families of 4 or more children are at the school concurrently: -

The youngest child will be educated for free

Laboratory consumables fee is a once-only payment made by pupils joining the school at R8 or above and is £250 covering laboratory and computer supplies.

Text books are provided to support the programmes of study in each subject. The text books remain in ownership of the college and will be expected to be returned when no longer required. Lost or damaged textbooks may be charged.

The registration fee (non-returnable) on application for all new pupils is £150. The registration fee for BNO pupils is £300.

The deposit payment (non-returnable but deducted from first term's fees) on accepting a place for new pupils is £500.

Public examination entry fees per GCSE subject, A level subject or External assessment are payable at the time of examination entry.

Notice of Withdrawal of a Pupil - A child may be withdrawn from the school if the headteacher is given **one full term's notice** in writing or if **one full term's fees** are paid in lieu of such notice.
